NEW RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

A very warm welcome to new residents and businesses to the town. Below is some information which may be useful to all:-

Town Council meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month. Meetings of the Finance & General Purposes Committee are held on the last Tuesday of the month excluding August and December. Both meetings take place in the Committee Room of the New Hall at 7 pm.

In addition, meetings of the Market Hill Committee take place as and when required and are held on Thursdays, commencing at 2pm in the Committee Room.

Notices of all Meetings are posted on council notice boards, on High Street and Oak Tree Road, and members of the public are most welcome to attend,

At Town Council meetings (but not Committee meetings) there is an opportunity for residents to raise issues of concern with councillors as we have a Public Participation item at the commencement of business. Alternatively you can contact any member of the town council or the clerk, details for which are given at the end of this Newsletter.

TOWN COUNCIL CONTROL

The Town Council has full responsibility for areas under its ownership, ie

- Memorial Sports Field
- Wharf Street Play Area (with the exception of the teen shelter and play area which is managed and owned by BARS, a registered charity)
- Pinfold (near to the Methodist Church)
- Seating area, corner Martin Lane/Doncaster Road
- Market Hill Pay and Display area only (ie excluding the frontages running the entire length of Market Hill)

Other areas, e.g. roads and pavements are the responsibility of Doncaster Council and we report defects on a regular basis.

MARKET HILL

A reminder that, subject to weather conditions and the contractor, re-lining of the Market Hill should take place at the end of February/beginning of March. The work will be carried out over a weekend and it is envisaged that the six disabled bays will all be positioned together, in front of the Wine Rack business.
